<p>Maths – Timetables Rockstars/ Numbots. Try and go on this everyday and beat your score (20 minutes). <i>We will continue to set competitions up!</i> <i>The White Rose website has videos and activities for you to try in Year group sections.</i></p>	<p>Follow a recipe and make something <i>or make up your own recipe!</i> What did you make? Write the down the ingredients and the measurements. How did the ingredients change? Who did you share it with? Take photos or draw what you did. <i>It's VE Day this week – you could make a menu and make food for a picnic with your family!</i></p>	<p>Play a board/card game with someone. <i>Can you make your own board or card game?</i> <i>KS1 : Make number cards – take turns to see who has the biggest. Snap too!</i> <i>KS2 : You could make a fractions game by having different fractions on cards. Share them out then take turns to see who has the largest fraction. Snap fractions that are the same!</i></p>
<p>Keep a diary of your time at home. <i>How are you feeling?</i> <i>What are you doing to make other people smile each day?</i> <i>Look on the Facebook page for ideas – try making cards and pictures for care homes or post them to friends.</i></p>	<p>Create a collage using things you have found outside. <i>Can you make a large picture of a rainbow / heart / animal using objects you've found?</i></p>	<p>Read your school book and other reading materials (newspapers, recipes, instructions etc) <i>Practice the spellings for your Year group (Find these on line).</i></p>
<p>Set your self a physical challenge e.g How many jumps can you do in a minute? Do this everyday and record it – can you improve? <i>If you can, go for a walk, run or bike ride each day. Write down something new you see on your travels and keep a list in your book.</i> <i>Try doing PE with Joe each day.</i></p>	<p>Use the list of websites below to practise reading, writing and maths skills. <i>Choose a famous person that you admire and find out information about – make a fact file to share with others.</i> <i>Find out about VE day and write a fact file / draw pictures showing what you did on this special day.</i></p>	<p>Do as many of the 100 things to do indoors on the Spread the Happiness sheet (tick them off). <i>Send what you have done on our school's Facebook page!</i></p>
